




# Coquitlam — Lincoln Station

Work to prepare for the construction of Lincoln Station will begin in early fall 2013. Construction activities will include installation of fencing, road works and changes to the mall parking at the station site area. Construction of the station foundation and the elevated guideway will begin in early 2014.

The completed Lincoln Station will feature extensive glass and well-lit areas allowing passengers to remain visible and safe while travelling on the Evergreen Line. The station entrance will be located at the north end of

the station at Northern Avenue and Pinetree Way.

Once inside the station, Evergreen Line passengers will may access the side platforms by stairs, elevator or escalators.

Lincoln Station will also have bike racks and lockers for cyclists. The bus stop along the east side of the station will serve residents and transit passengers as they connect to the existing transit system from Lincoln Station. Along the west side of the station, there will be a dedicated stop for HandyDART service.

## Lincoln Station

Lincoln Station is located adjacent to Coquitlam Centre Mall at the corner of Pinetree Way and Northern Avenue and across from the City Centre Library.

Located in the heart of a growing commercial and residential area of Coquitlam, Lincoln Station will serve the mall and more than a dozen existing and planned residential and retail developments located within a short walk of the station. The new station supports the planning goals outlined in the city of Coquitlam’s Official Community Plan for the City Centre to become a sustainable, high density urban core.

Lincoln Station is being funded through a unique partnership between the Government of Canada, the City of Coquitlam and the owners of Coquitlam Centre Mall.

## WHAT IS THE EVERGREEN LINE?

The Evergreen Line is a new rapid transit line that will connect Coquitlam to Vancouver via Port Moody and Burnaby. It will be a fast, frequent and convenient SkyTrain service, connecting Coquitlam City Centre in approximately 15 minutes. It will connect without transfer to the Millennium Line and the current SkyTrain network at Lougheed Town Centre Station and will integrate with the regional bus and West Coast Express networks. The Evergreen Line will be in service in the summer of 2016.
